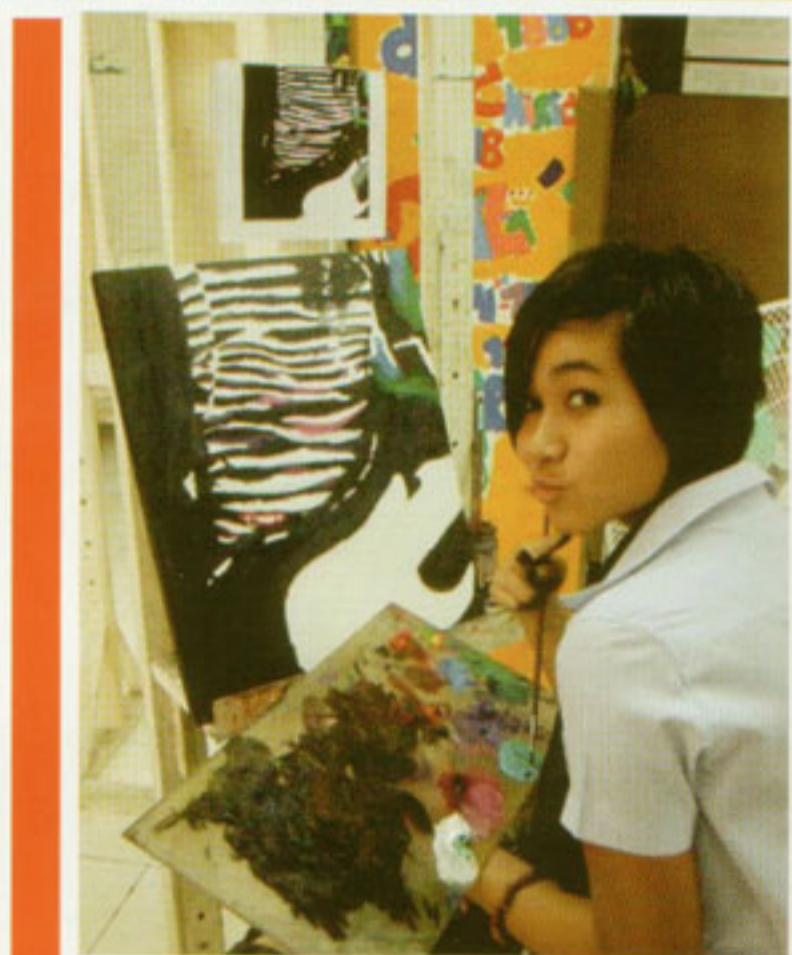
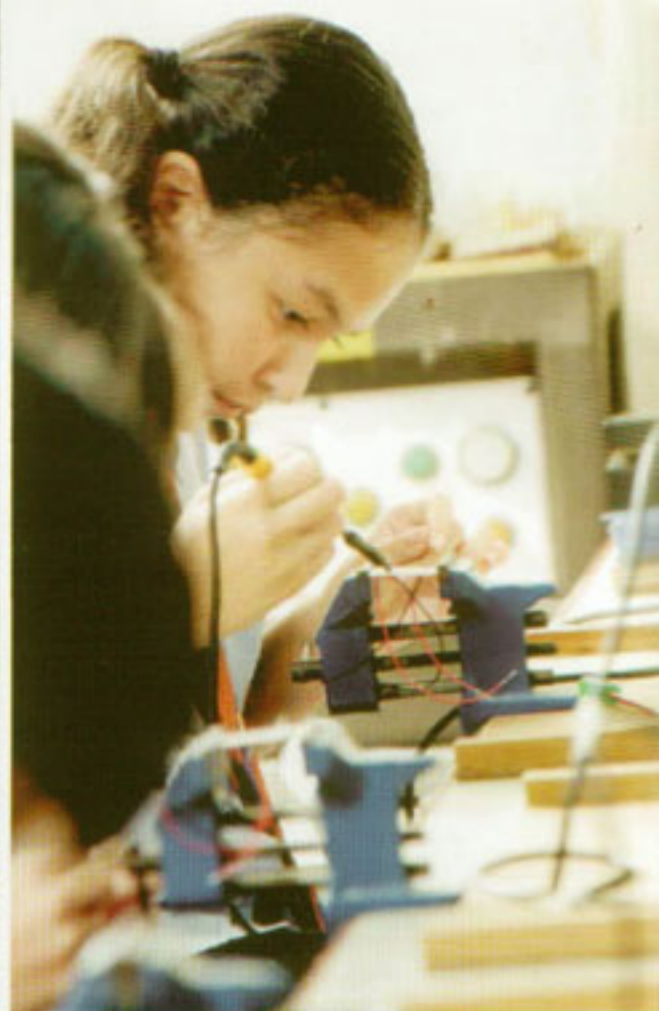

Admission Requirements

[Please read these requirements carefully before filling out the Application Form for entry]

The school strives to maintain the provision of a high quality education to all its pupils. These admission requirements are designed to ensure that education of such quality will be available to your children at all times.

1. New pupils are usually admitted for the start of the school year in August. Entries may be accepted at other times of the year and will be considered on an individual basis.
2. All applicants must fill in the *Application Form* and return it with the necessary documentation (photos, school report, Birth certificate, House Registration Document, Passport copies) and the *Application & Testing Fee*, to the Admissions office. We need to have the original **Application Form**. Photocopies or faxes are only acceptable at the initial stage.
3. All applicants must take the BIS entrance test. The test takes 3 to 4 hours for Secondary, about 1 to 2 hours for Primary and about half an hour for Kindergarten. Subjects examined will include General Aptitude, Mathematical Ability and English Ability at appropriate levels.
4. Pupils who are up to one year older than the age for their entry class may be admitted. The pupil's age on 1st September of the academic year of entry would normally determine the class he or she would enter.
5. Normally admission to the school is through classes K1 to Y10 and Year 12, at the required age of entry as shown here:

6. Pupils will be eligible for admission to the Intensive English As A Second Language Programme (IESL) if:
 - a) they are aged 11 or above for the academic year for which they are applying.
 - b) their performances in the General Aptitude and Maths papers are high.
 - c) they satisfy the IESL testing procedures
7. The school does not admit any new pupil into Years 11 or 13 (except in very special circumstances where the pupil has been following a curriculum very similar to that of BIS and has performed exceptionally well in his or her previous school and the BIS entrance test).
8. Pupils may be admitted to follow the two year IB programme by entering the Year 12 class (at age 16), provided they have followed an appropriate curriculum in their previous school, and their performance in the previous school and in the BIS entrance test is acceptable.
9. The school does not admit pupils who are older than 17.
10. The pupil's performance in the entrance test is a very important factor in the school's decision to admit the pupil, but past performance in previous schools and other relevant factors such as the pupil's age and the Term of entry will also be considered in arriving at the final decision to admit or reject the pupil.
11. Conditional offers of entry may be made in some cases, in appropriate circumstances.
12. Entrance tests are held at the school by appointment only. Please contact the school for an appointment. Pupils will not be allowed to take the entrance test unless the original Application Form with any school reports, other required documents and the Testing Fee have been received. Pupils should not arrive at the school for an entrance test without prior arrangement.
13. A decision regarding placement is normally made within 3 working days of the test date unless otherwise advised.
